Dear Parents,

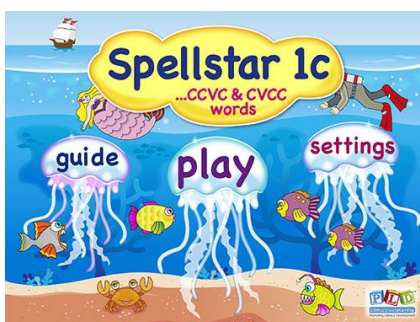
Landsdale Primary School follows a whole school synthetic phonic and spelling program to assist children in cracking the codes of reading and spelling.

This involves a phonic and sight word sequence that is research based and builds each year on student's previous word knowledge. Students are taught specific skills to help them decode words that involve auditory (hearing), visual (seeing) and fine motor skills (using the hands).
