

2018 ICAS Mathematics Testing



The International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS) is an independent, skills-based assessment program which recognises and rewards student achievement.

Landsdale Primary School students are able to nominate to complete the Mathematics test which includes mathematical skills in a range of contexts across Algebra and Patterns, Chance and Data, Measures and Units, Number and Arithmetic, and Space and Geometry.

Testing occurs on Tuesday August 14th 2018. All nominations must be notified to the school by Monday June 18th. The cost for each student, payable with nomination, is \$9.90 per student.

An individual report evaluating student performance, and a certificate, is provided for each student participating in ICAS.

Each student's report shows:

- the student's answer to each question as well as the correct answer
- the performance of each student in the different skill areas assessed
- the progress of each student every year over the past eight years
- the student's comparative performance against the reporting region
