

Do you want to help your child be ready for pre-primary or year one in 2016?

Step One Occupational Therapy for Children can help. Enrolments for our **School Readiness Groups** are now open.

What services do we offer?

School readiness groups aim to develop skills necessary for academic learning in pre primary or year one. These include sensory-motor coordination, visual perceptual development and hand skills. There are four to six children in each group and the groups are run by a fully qualified occupational therapist.

If your child has not been assessed by an occupational therapist in the last six months, an individual **free screening** assessment will need to be completed prior to commencement. These will be conducted in December 2015. Call now to book your place.

Where are the groups run?

The groups are held at the premises of Step One Occupational Therapy for Children. The environment is bright, fun and filled with lots of equipment and toys used to develop a variety of skills.

When is the program run?

The school readiness groups are run twice a week commencing January 6th and ending January 29th. Group times will depend on numbers. Each session is one hour.

How much does it cost?

Each session is \$45 bringing the total of the eight sessions to \$360. There is also a one off \$10 amenities fee. A \$50 deposit is required to confirm your child's place in the group. We request that the remaining amount is paid in full at the first session. If you have private health insurance you may be able to claim back on the sessions. The group code is H300.
