TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

About

Perth Observatory presents the first Lowell Dome Art Competition. This competition is to celebrate the 50 year anniversary of the Lowell Dome and telescope.

- Participants must draw or paint the Lowell Dome in their own style. All artwork outside of photography and meeting the eligibility conditions will be accepted.
- The Observatory will be open weekdays 10-4 and Sundays 11-3 for artists to visit and get references, reference images will also be supplied on request.
- This competition is open to all participants but will be split into two categories: **Nebula** for participants 13 years and younger and **SuperNovae** for participants 14 and older.
- It is free entry for the Nebula category and each artwork submitted to the SuperNovae category will have a \$5 submission fee.

Awards

- Winner of Nebula Category: Art Supply Pack, Perth Observatory Gift Bag
- Winner of SuperNovae: \$100, Night Sky Tour Double Pass, Observatory prize pack, artwork displayed permanently at Perth Observatory.
- Commendations: Night Sky Tour Double Pass
- People's Choice Award: \$100, Night Sky Tour Double Pass.

How to Submit

- Art can be digital or physical, but no larger than A1 size
- Digital artwork must be a minimum 300dpi.
- All artwork must be ready to be displayed and be submitted with an entry sheet with artwork & artist name and contact details.
- Physical art must be able to be hung, pinned, or taped.
- Perth Observatory takes no responsibility for damage to the original artwork.
- All artwork must be dropped off at the Perth Observatory, 337 Walnut Road Bickley, or emailed to LowellComp@perthobservatory.com.au before April 20th 2021.
- Digital artwork will be on a rotating display, while physical art will be hung in the Perth Observatory foyer for the full month of April 2021.

Continued

Conditions of Entry

- Artist 13 and under must submit to the Nebula category and have a parent/guardian's permission to enter.
- Artists 14 and over must submit to the SuperNovae category
- All media outside of photography is accepted.
- Submission for Nebula is free
- The submission fee for SuperNovae: \$5 per work
- No maximum number of artworks submitted.
- All paintings must be well presented. Physical copies must be ready to hang, They can be framed, or else they will be either pinned or taped to the display area.
- Digital and scanned copies must be of high-resolution 300dpi minimum.
- Artworks must be titled and have the artist's name attached.
- Artwork must be suitable to display for all ages, this includes no profanity, offensive or explicit content.
- Works that are poorly presented or differ significantly from the photograph entered will not be exhibited.
- All Artwork must be submitted before April 20th 2021, no late submissions will be accepted.
- Artwork must be collected at the end of the display period if you wish to keep it or else will be retained by the Observatory.
- The winning artworks will be displayed at the Perth Observatory unless winners chose to keep their own artwork.
- When the competition is over, the artist must collect art from the Perth Observatory and if not collected will be retained by the Observatory.
- All submissions must have the Lowell dome in them and creativity is encouraged.
- Winners announced at the Lowell 50th Anniversary Event, April 24th 2021, via contact details and online.
- Artist's 13 years and under must have a parent or guardian accompany them on Perth Observatory property.
- The Artist acknowledges that their artwork may be photographed and used for marketing, social media, and other publications approved by The Perth Observatory.
