

POLICY 1 STUDENT DRESS CODE

1. Students should ensure that they take appropriate protection from the sun when outdoors. No hat – No play in the sun! is our policy.
2. No thongs, health or beach sandals are permitted.
3. “Fad” clothing or accessories will not be permitted e.g. bunny ear headbands, fluoro/bright socks or other items deemed to be opposed to the spirit and intent of the school’s student dress code.
4. Jewellery – For safety reasons children may wear the following items of jewellery only:
 - Earrings – studs or sleepers only
 - A watch
