One fascinating way Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People communicate is through the use of a message stick to deliver messages between clans and countries. Messages were drawn onto, or etch into long pieces of wood; with different clans and countries having particular patterns to identify who the messenger was. These message sticks were delivered by hand across Country.



The year two students have created their own personal message stick expressing their cultural heritage through imagery, and a name plate representing themselves through drawing.
